



## Inward Processing / End Use relief –Bills of Discharge

<b>Who should read:</b>	Holders of Inward Processing and End Use Authorisations
<b>What is it about:</b>	Availability of new Bills of Discharge for Inward Processing and End Use relief for the Union Customs Code.
<b>When effective:</b>	Immediately
<b>Extant until/ Expires</b>	

### 1. Background

The Union Customs Code requires a Bill of Discharge to be submitted for all discharges from Inward Processing and End Use relief from 1 May 2016, irrespective of the date of import.

### 2. Forms

Four new Bill of Discharge forms will shortly be available on [www.gov.uk](http://www.gov.uk). These forms should be used for all discharges from the regimes from 1<sup>st</sup> May. The current forms (C&E 812 and C99 should not be used).

The forms available are:

- BOD 1: Inward processing using a full authorisation
- BOD2: End Use relief using a full authorisation
- BOD3: Inward processing using an authorisation by declaration
- BOD4: End Use relief using an authorisation by declaration.
